Position Summary: MAISA is seeking a Director to administer the program, build the daily operational functions, and plan the strategic roadmap for the Michigan Great Data Lake. MiGreatDataLake works under the guidance of the MAISA MiCH Director to support, promote, and lead the evolution of the Michigan Great Data Lake for the Michigan Association of Intermediate School Administrators (MAISA). - Oversee the technical operations of the Michigan Great Data Lake with a focus on student outcomes
- Maintain effective governance and data governance strategies in accordance with FERPA and any other legislated privacy requirements.
- Ensure processes are in place to secure the MiGreatDataLake applications and architecture
- Effectively supervise Michigan Great Data Lake Staff and Operations, with a focus on growth
